

CUSHION STORAGE BENCH- #2028- #2054

Quality Western Red Cedar with Handcrafted Construction

Assembly Instructions: All holes are pre-drilled and screws are included. Check all packing material carefully before discarding as shortages of parts may occur from parts left in packaging. Read instructions carefully before beginning to assemble your CUSHION STORAGE BENCH.

Please keep in mind that this product is designed for outdoor use but is NOT a waterproof product and should not be used for dry storage.

Tools Required for Assembly: #2 Phillips screwdriver or an electric screwdriver with a #2 Phillips head bit

PARTS LIST:

Note: Bench parts are shipped in 2 boxes	8- 3” Screws for walls
1 Cushioned Top	8- 1” Screws for Hinges & Chain
2 Long Panels with Legs (Front & Back)	
Note: The back panel has pre-marked holes for hinges	
2 Short Panels (Sides)	1 Plywood Base w/ Weep Holes

ASSEMBLY:

NOTE: This assembly is best executed with two people.

STEP 1: Place the 4 Panels upside down on a flat surface in order to form a box
(See illustration)

STEP 2: Screw the 4 Panels together with the 8- 3” screws in the pre-drilled holes
Note: The 2 Short Side Panels go to the INSIDE of the Long Panels
Note: ALL panels are marked with “BOTTOM” which will face INSIDE

STEP 3: Turn the Cushioned Bench Box so the legs are on the floor

STEP 4: Insert the Plywood Base in the bottom of the box

STEP 5: Cushioned Top Assembly: Locate the back of the box by locating the pre-marked holes for the hinges. Lay the Cushioned Bench Top on TOP of the box with the hinges on the OUTSIDE of the box. Line up the hinge holes with the pre-marked holes and secure the hinges to the box with the 1” screws.

STEP 6: Move the bench near a wall so that you may rest the cushioned top against a wall
Secure the chain to the INSIDE of the short side panel with the 1” screws

Note: Western Red Cedar contains natural preservatives, so it resists rot, and weathers well. These qualities make cedar ideal for outdoor use. A quality sealer or stain on all areas will delay the graying of the wood and give additional protection. Cedar will weather to a silvery gray if left in its natural state. We would recommend a location for your garden planter that will receive full sun light. Ordinary soil is too heavy for container gardening and we would recommend a light pre-mixed soil.
