

PLANTER WITH TRELLIS- #2034TR
INCLUDES: #2034PT AND #5000 TRELLIS
Quality Western Red Cedar with Handcrafted Construction

Assembly Instructions: All holes are pre-drilled and screws are included. Check all packing material carefully before discarding as shortages of parts may occur from parts left in packaging. Read instructions carefully before beginning to assemble your PLANTER WITH TRELLIS.

Tools Required for Assembly: #2 Phillips screwdriver or an electric screwdriver with a #2 Phillips head bit

PARTS LIST:

2 Long Panels with Legs (Front & Back)	2 Trellis Sections
2 Short Panels (Sides)	3- 1x 2 Boards for Trellis Assembly
8- 1x 4 Slats for base (bottom)	
8- 3" Long Screws for Planter	
32- 1 ¼" Small Screws for Trellis	

ASSEMBLY:

NOTE: This assembly is best executed with two people.

STEP 1: Place the 4 Panels upside down on a flat surface in order to form a box
(See illustration A)

STEP 2: Screw the 4 Panels together with the 8- 3" screws in the pre-drilled holes
Note: The 2 Short Side Panels go to the **INSIDE** of the Long Panels
Note: ALL panels are marked with "BOTTOM" which will face **INSIDE**

STEP 3: Turn the Planter over so the legs are on the ground

STEP 4: Assemble the Trellis by placing the 2 Trellis Sections side by side on the ground
with the diamond pattern facing down (See illustration B)

STEP 5: Place one of the 1"x 2" Boards at the top of the two trellis pieces. Using the
pilot holes and the 1 ¼" screws attach the horizontal 1"x 2" board to the trellis.
Place the other two 1"x 2" boards centered between the diamond patterns
as shown in illustration B. Using the pilot holes and 1 ¼" screws attach each
horizontal 1"x 2" boards to the trellis.

STEP 6: Turn the Planter as shown in illustration C. Using the pilot holes and the
1 ¼" screws attach the trellis to the planter.

STEP 7: Insert the 8- 1'x 4" slats into the bottom of the planter spacing them evenly

Note: Western Red Cedar contains natural preservatives, so it resists rot, and weathers well. These qualities make cedar ideal for outdoor use. A quality sealer or stain on all areas will delay the graying of the wood and give additional protection. Cedar will weather to a silvery gray if left in its natural state. We would recommend a location for your garden planter that will receive full sun light. Ordinary soil is too heavy for container gardening and we would recommend a light pre-mixed soil.
